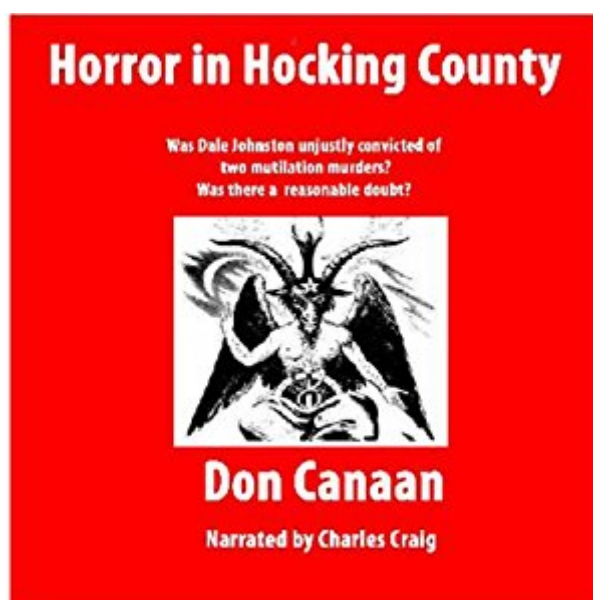


The book was found

Synopsis

Dale Johnston was arrested, tried and convicted for the dismemberment murders of his stepdaughter, Annette Cooper, and her fiancé, Todd Schultz. He was sentenced to die in the electric chair.
